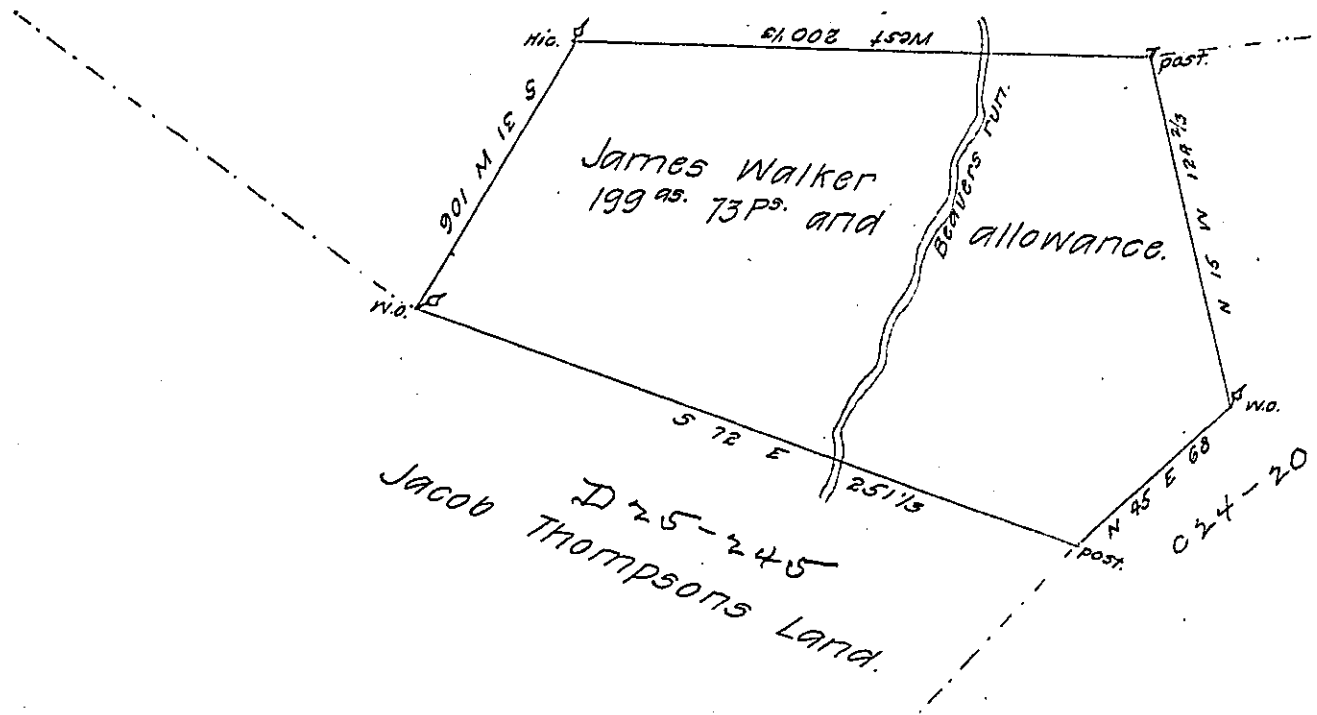

James Blairs Claim

In pursuance of a Warrant dated September 22<sup>nd</sup> 1788 there was Surveyd for James Walker the above described tract of land containing One Hundred & ninety nine Acres and Seventy three perches with an allowance proportioned to Six P Cent Situate on both sides of Beavers run adjoining Land of Jacob Thompson and others in Salem township Westmoreland County Surveyd May 15th 1789.
