A Draught of a Survey called "Ward's Ward" situate on the waters of Cross Cr. in Washington County, contain<sup>g</sup>. 400 Ac<sup>s</sup>. strict measure, executed Feby. 25<sup>th</sup>. 1786 in consequence of a Certif<sup>t</sup> for 400 Ac<sup>s</sup> granted to Thomas Ward by the Commiss<sup>rs</sup>. appointed by Virg<sup>a</sup>. to adjust the claims to unpatented lands in the Counties Monong<sup>a</sup>. Yohg<sup>a</sup>. and Ohio and duly entered with the County Sur<sup>s</sup>.
