



A Draft of four acres & 124 perches of land with the allowance of six per cent for roads &c. situate in Brown Township Mifflin County, which is cleared and has been cultivated since the spring of 1813 and which appears from papers on file in this office, to have been surveyed by William Harris on the 13th June 1805 and returned on an application of John Templeton dated 27th Novr. 1786 but was not accepted by reason there was no vacancy as Wm. Brown & Robt Taylor cornered on the same post. And was resurveyed by Wm. Shaw on the 17th day of March 1839. Both of which I have examined and corrected this 24th day of August 1839 and return the same by virtue of a Warrant granted John Taylor dated the 20th August 1839.
