

Surveyed May 5th 1815 for George Wilt the above described Island situate in the River Susquehanna called, "Fisher's Island" about three quarters of a mile from the Dauphin County shore, and bounding an Island called Welch's Island situate in Upper Paxton Township Dauphin County containing six acres and a quarter Strict measure by his Warrant dated the 17th August 1814
