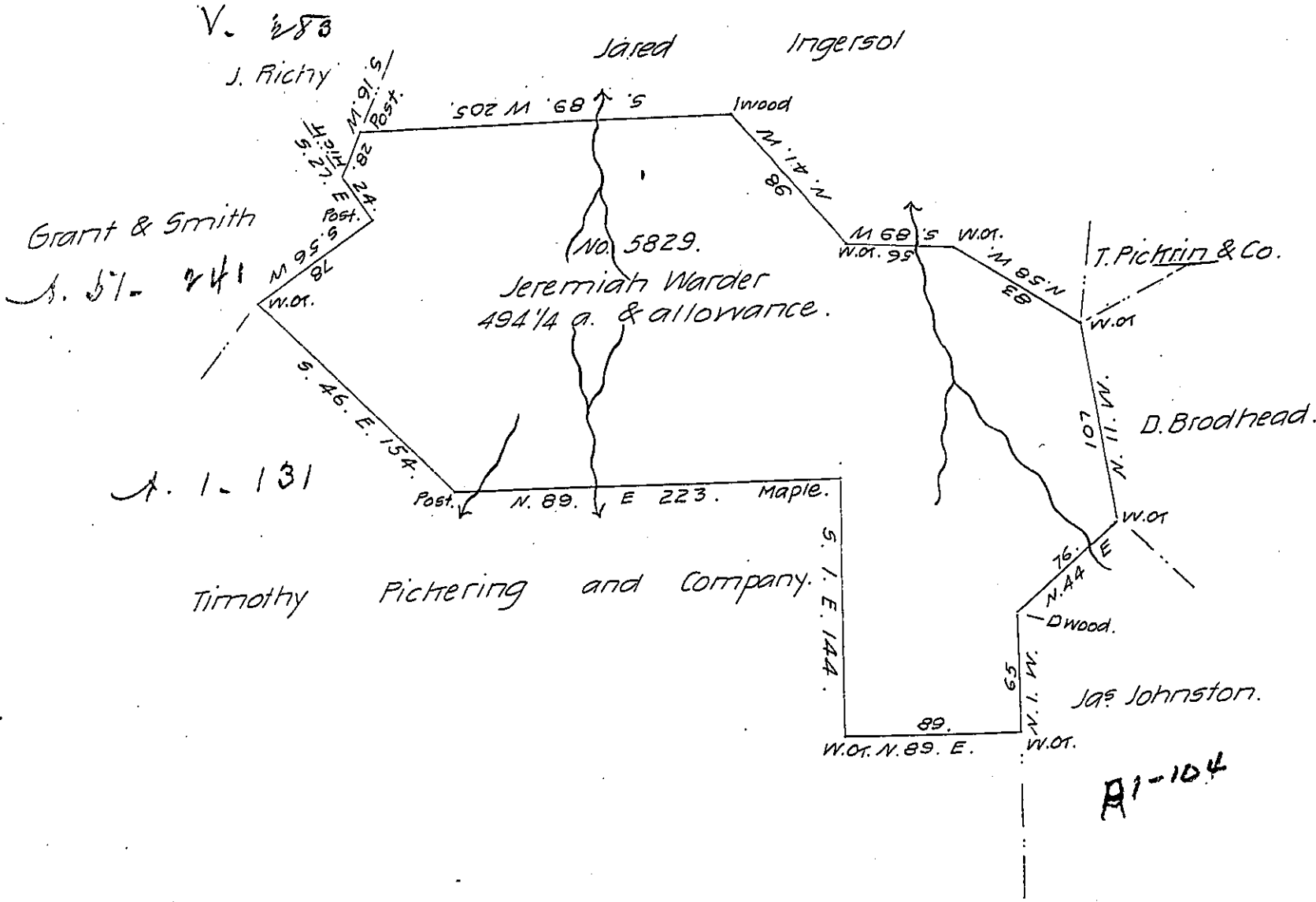

27th January A.D. 1835. The above described tract of land was surveyed to Jeremiah Warder on the 19th day of November 1801 by Wm. P. Brady for James Johnston Deputy Surveyor, on the south side of little Mahoning creek adjoining James Richey and others in Indiana County, Mahoning township, containing four hundred & ninety four acres & one quarter of an acre and allowance by warrant of the 11th of June 1800, No. 5829. I have examined the above from papers in my office and find it to be correct & so make return.
