Situate in District No. 6, in the Late Purchase, on the East side of the Allegheny River, adjoining Wilhem Willink and others, No. 2681, by virtue of a Warrant to Wilhem Willink, Nicolaas Van Staphorst, Christiaan Van Eeghen, Hendrich Vollenhoven, and Rutger Jan Schirmmelpenninck of Amsterdam, No. 2682, dated the twelfth day of December 1792
