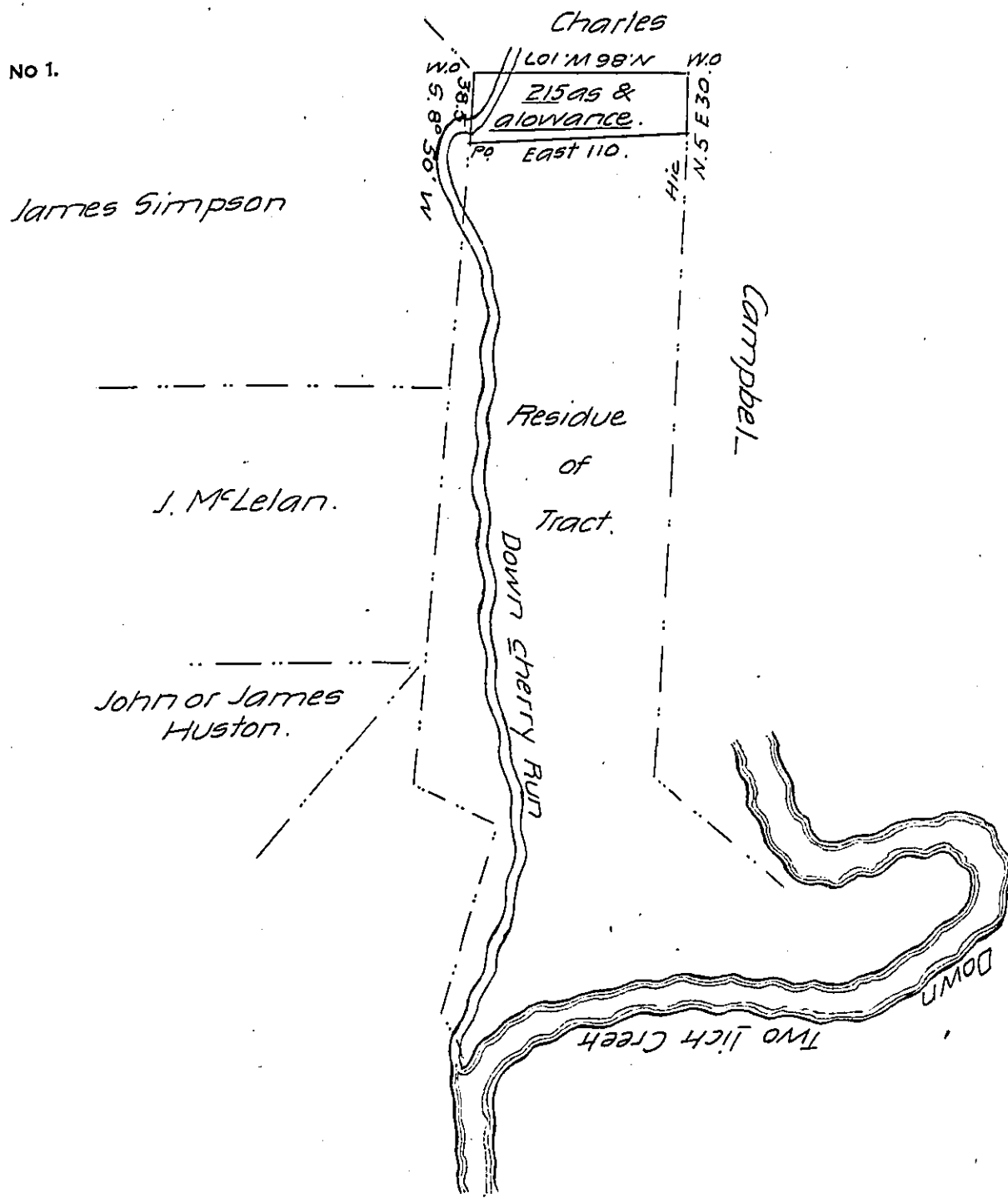


FORM NO 1.



December 31st, 1833. Survied to John Willson the above discribed tract of twenty one acres and one half of an acre and allowance for Roads &c. Being a parte of a larger tract Survied to Edward Harbridg on the 21st of may 1770. By order of the 3rd of april 1769 No. 523 as appears from peapers in my office and adjoining Charles Campbel, James Simpson and others in Center township, Indiana County.
