Township, Fayette County and surveyed the 13th day of NovE 1774 ~ but there being Errors in that Survey they are now Corrected and the Courses altered to the present Variation and Difference of Instruments therefore properly dated the 29th Day of September 1785 In Pursuance of a Warrant dated the seventeenth day of October ~ 1774 ~
