



Situate in Reading Township Adams County being part of 116^a & allce surveyed April 4th 1748 by Tho^s Cookson, D.S. by warrant to Daniel Slegle dated August 20th 1747. Divided from the residue January 8th 1818 for Dan! Oblenis Containing twenty seven acres eighty six perches & allce. Daniel Slegle took out 2 warrants for land in Reading Township dated Dec^r 15th 1792, one for 30^a the other for 180^a the larger one calling for land adjoining Jacob Bowser & the forks of Conewago the small one for land adjoining Martin John from which description they appear to have been taken for the above and 206^a 74 ps. part of a tract sur^d this day on order of Survey to Daniel Slegle N^o 5138 dated AUGUST ~~25th~~ 26th 1768 making together 234^a & all (See return of said whole tract.)
