



Draught of a Tract of Land which from documents in my Office appears to have been Surveyed the 2nd day of Sept. 1786 by James Sample then D.S. in pursuance of a warrant granted to Henry Slaughter bearing date February 4th. 1774 Said to contain One Hundred and twenty two Acres and Twenty Six perches and Allowance. But by an examination of the lines on the ground the 10th. day of March 1818 found to contain One Hundred and thirteen Acres and Ninety six perches and Allowance of Six per Cent Situated in Donegal Township, Westmoreland County.
