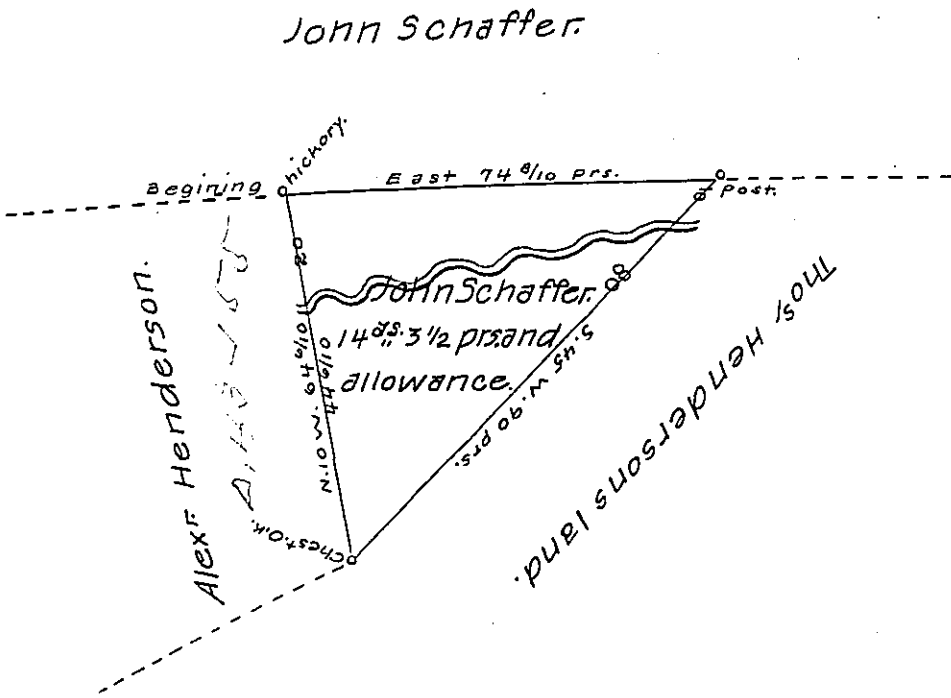


N.B. Charles Henderson claims this tract of land by
