

The above is a draught of a survey made April the first day 1794 in pursuance of a warrant granted to John Woods dated February the tenth day 1794, adjoining James Miller to the eastward of the Venango Path situate North and West of the River Ohio, Allegheny and Conawango Creek on the waters of Pine Creek called Pine Grove containing four hundred thirty nine acres one quarter together with the usual allowance of six per cent for Roads.
