



The above is a Draught of a resurvey, made Feb^y. 9th. 1826, in pursuance of an order of the Board of Property, granted to Ezra Dille, dated Jan^y. 30th. 1826, containing Fifty Acres, and eighty one perches, and allowance of six per Cent, for high-ways, situate in Morris Township, W. C. on the head waters of the middle fork of Ten mile Creek, on which there is an actual settlement, and Improvement, It appears that an erroneous Survey, had been made on the above tract of Land and returned in pursuance of a Warrant granted to John Whiting, dated November 21st 1788.
