


FORM NO 1.



The above described tract of one hundred and twenty three acres  
 ab[st] six perches & allowance of six per cent for Roads &c is part of a larger tract  
 of  $329 \frac{25}{33} \frac{29}{32}$  & allowance, situate in Guilford Township, Franklin County,  
 which was surveyed the 15<sup>th</sup> December 1790. In pursuance of an order of  
 survey granted to William Vanlear, bearing date the 18<sup>th</sup> of March 1767  
 No 3084. Resurveyed & divided off the 10<sup>th</sup> of June 1823.
