In pursuance of a Warrant No 2595 to Wilhem Willint, Nicholaas Van Staphorst, Christian Van Egten, Hendrik Vollenhoven & Rutger Jan Schimmelpenninck of Amsterdam Dated the twelfth day of December 1792, for 900 A<sup>s</sup> Containing Nine Hundred & Ninety Acres & the Usual Allowance of Six p<sup>ct</sup> for Roads &c.
