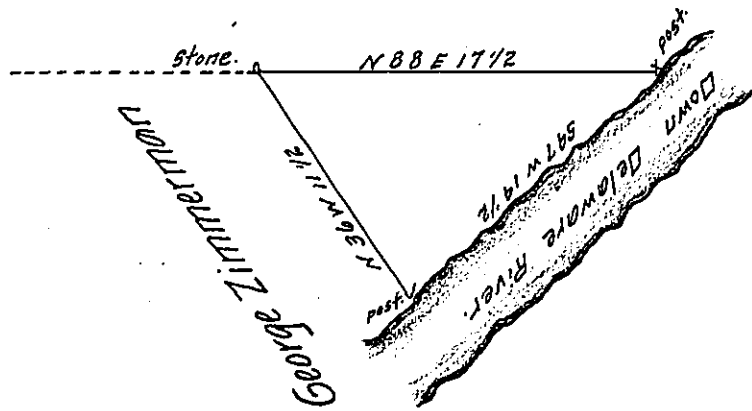


## The heirs of Philip Strawder Decd
