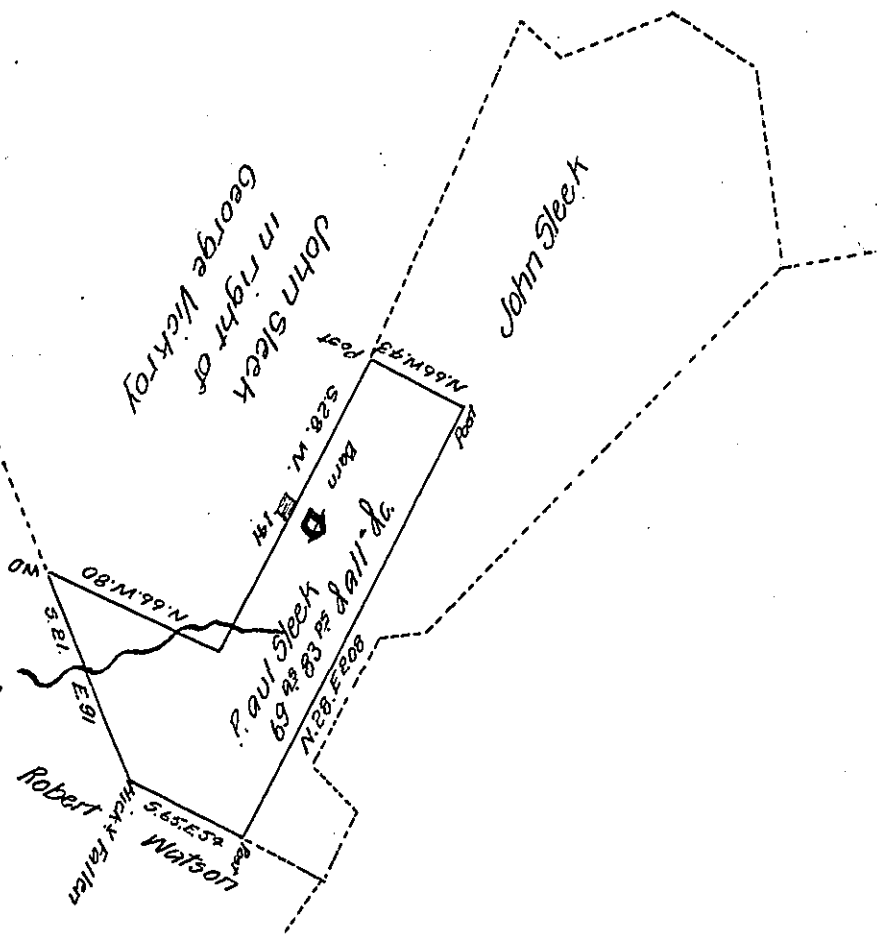


Situate in 5th Clair township

N.B. John Sleek claims the above 69 acres 83 perches & allowance of land by
 virtue of a Warrant dated the 7th January 1794 granted to the said John Sleek
 for 125 acres which said Warrant I executed at the same time I made the above
 Survey

The said John Sleek had desired me to execute his Warrant some time pre-
 vious to the date of Paul Sleeks Warrant viz - the 6th Nov. 1840. to which I
 could not attend on account of previous engagement until the time of the
 above Survey.

The above 69 acres &c take in John Sleeks Barn & orchard with about 30
 acres of cleared land some of it cleared at least 30 years ago and at the
 time of the above surveys in the tenure and possession of the said John
 Sleek who was present and asserted his claim
