



A Draught of a tract of land Situate in Brooklyn Township Susquehanna County Adjoining a tract of land on the North, in the Warrantee of Phillip Frict. on the East by land in the Warrantee name of Isaac Baldwin on the South by a tract warranted in the name of Samuel Baldwin, on the South West by vacant land, and West by a tract in the Warrantee name of Roger Harvey, Surveyed the tenth day of July A.D. 1891 for John Wood in pursuance of a Warrant bearing date the 6th day of July A.D. 1891. Containing One hundred and thirty eight Acres, and twenty two perches and the usual allowance of Six per cent for Roads &c. Containing an improvement of about five acres. Said improvement was made about the first of June 1837.

Remarks: the above tract of land in the name of John Wood appears to have been left between Isaac Baldwin and Roger Harvey by Parrellell lines; Blocted the line trees but could not find the date of the original Survey. I counted 22 24 27 grains. the lines had evident appearance of being marked two or three times.
