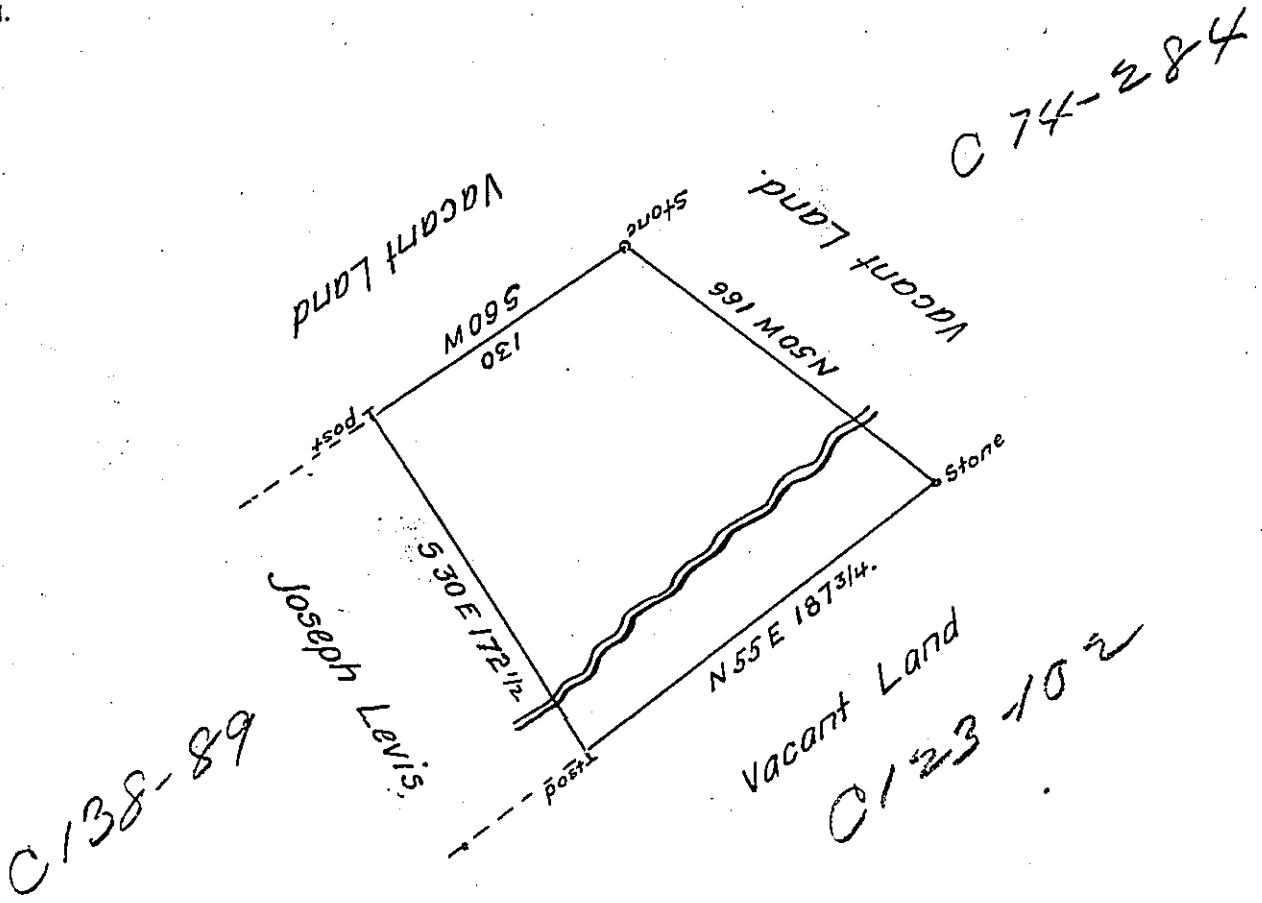


FORM NO. 1.



By Virtue of an Application dated the 5<sup>th</sup> August 1765 Surveyed the
