



The above is a Draught of a Survey made March 9th 1827 in pursuance of a warrant granted to Samuel McCrory for Five Acres of land, (directed to my predecessor but not executed by him) but containing Forty four Acres and thirty eight perches, and allowance of six per Cent for highways, situate on the waters of Wheeling Creek in Finley Township W. C. warrant Dated June 11th 1819. at the time of Survey there was no improvement, but in running the line next to Mawhorter it took in about five Acres of Mawhorters field he had Cleared over the line
