Containing one hundred and twenty two Acres and forty six perches and the allowance of six per Cent for roads &c surveyed to Jacob Branstedner the 10<sup>th</sup> day of August 1748 & by warrant dated the 12<sup>th</sup> day of May 1758 returned the same day into the Secretary's Office.
