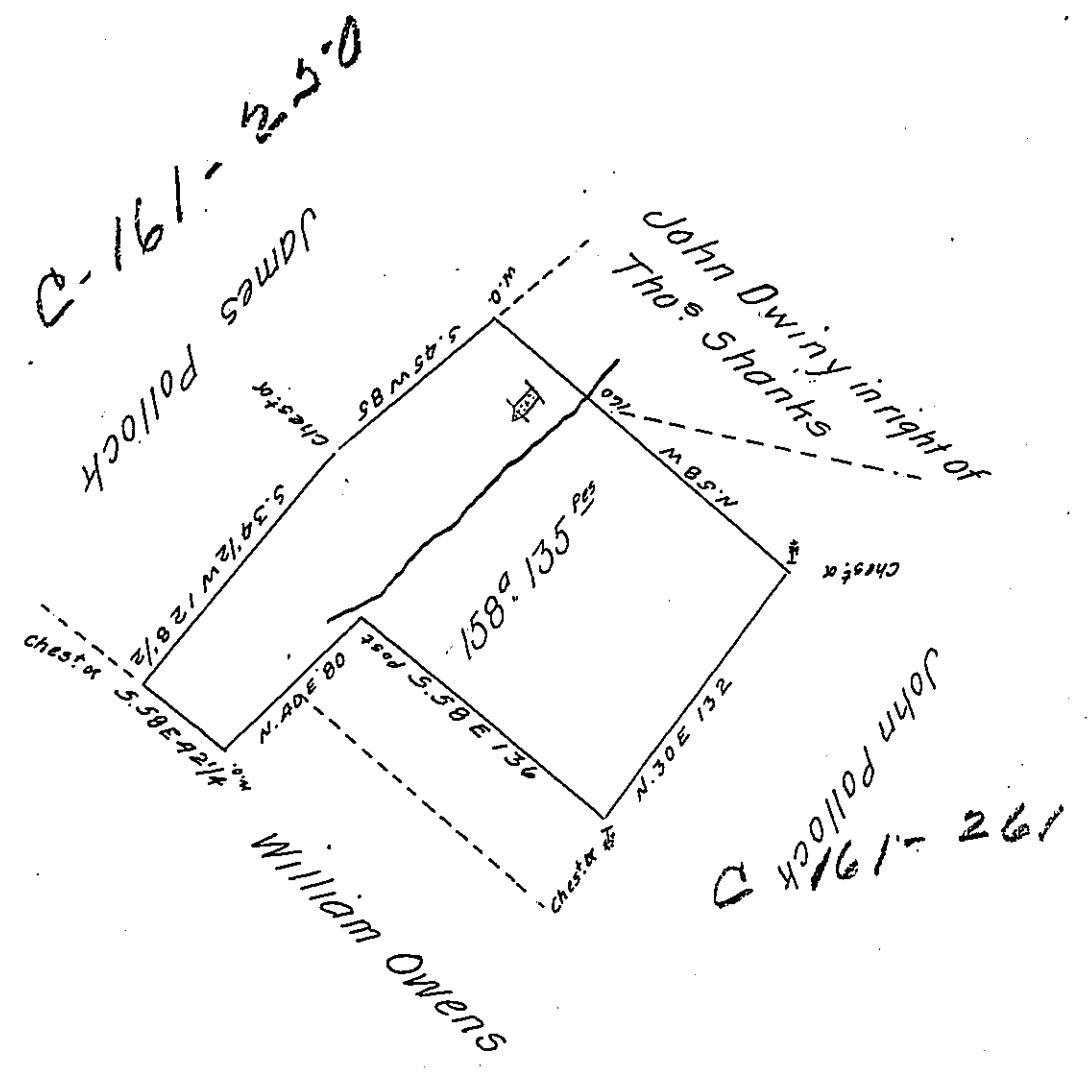


FORM NO. 1.



A Draught of one hundred and fifty eight acres and one hundred and thirty five perches of land with six per cent for road &c. which appears to have been surveyed 17th October 1794 in pursuance of a warrant to William White dated 7th October 1786 said to contain 150^a & 113 perches. Situated in Lack township in Mifflin County. Resurveyed 17th June 1809 ^{at} the request of James Pollock
