



Draft of a tract of land Situated in Cole Brook township in the county of Clinton Containing one hundred and Sixtytwo acres and eighty seven perches and allowance of six per cent for roads &c. Surveyed for James Wilson, the 23^d day of December A.D. 1869, being part of a larger tract of land originally surveyed in pursuance of a warrant granted to the said James Wilson dated the 12th day of May, A.D. 1830, and 330 acres returned, this tract interferes with Thomas Grant and William P. Brady as above represented by dotted lines, and only 162 acres and 87 perches remain unencumbered.
