



Situate on Licking Creek in Belfast Township, Fulton County (formerly part of Bedford) Containing ninety Eight acres and ninety perches and allowance of Six per Cent for roads &c. Surveyd by Michael Reed, the 10<sup>th</sup> day of May 1845, for John Waltz the present Owner and occupant on warrant dated 11<sup>th</sup> February 1822, granted to Conrod Waltz for 50 acres &c. Examined March 4<sup>th</sup> 1852.
