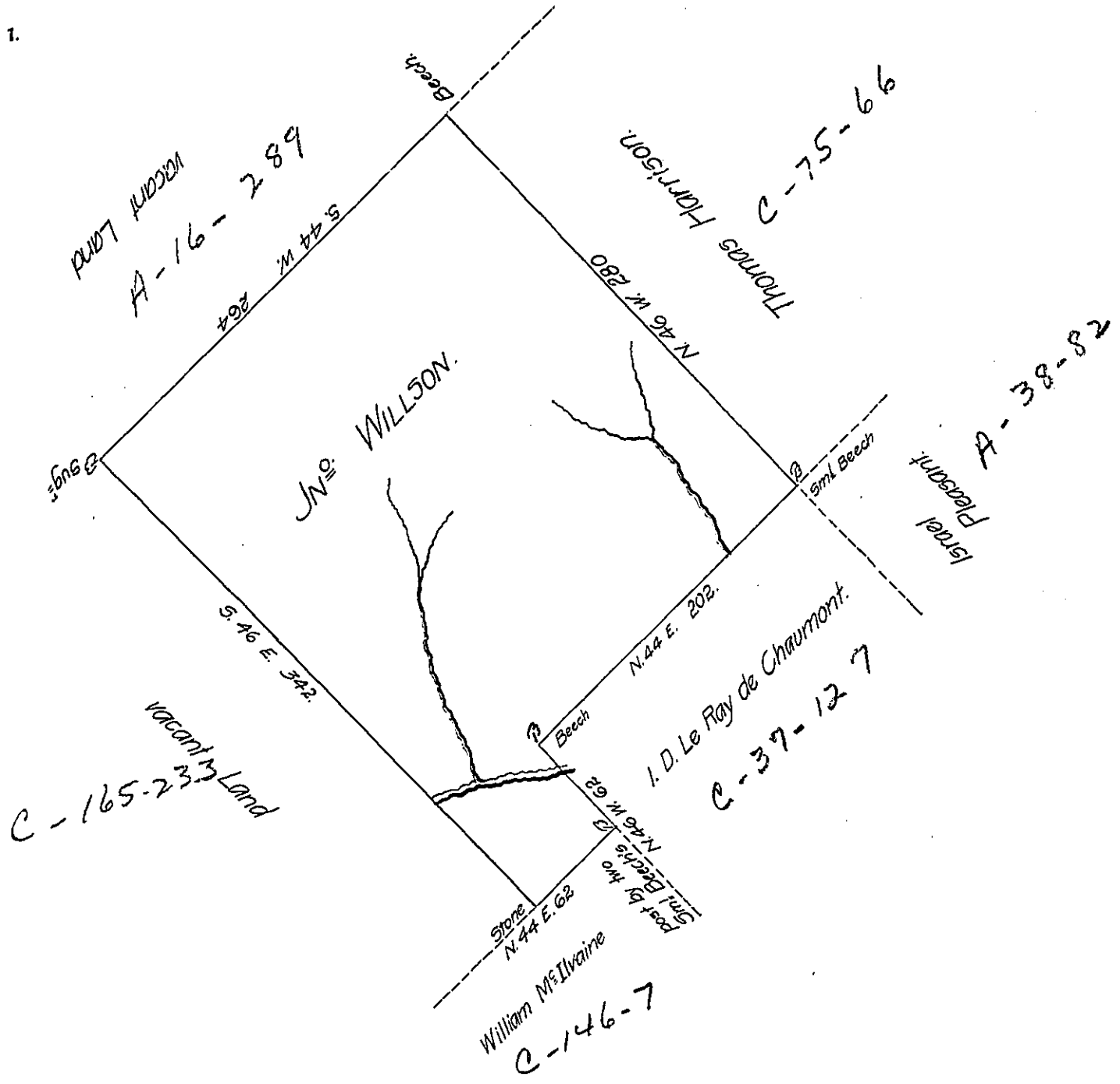


FORM NO. 1.

Surveyed the 27 October, 1787, to John Wilson the above described tract of land situate on the branches of a Creek emptying in Susquehanna at the great Bend in Northampton County, Containing four hundred & fifty-eight Acres eighty two perches and the allowance of Six ~~per~~ Cent  $\frac{1}{2}$  c<sup>o</sup>.
