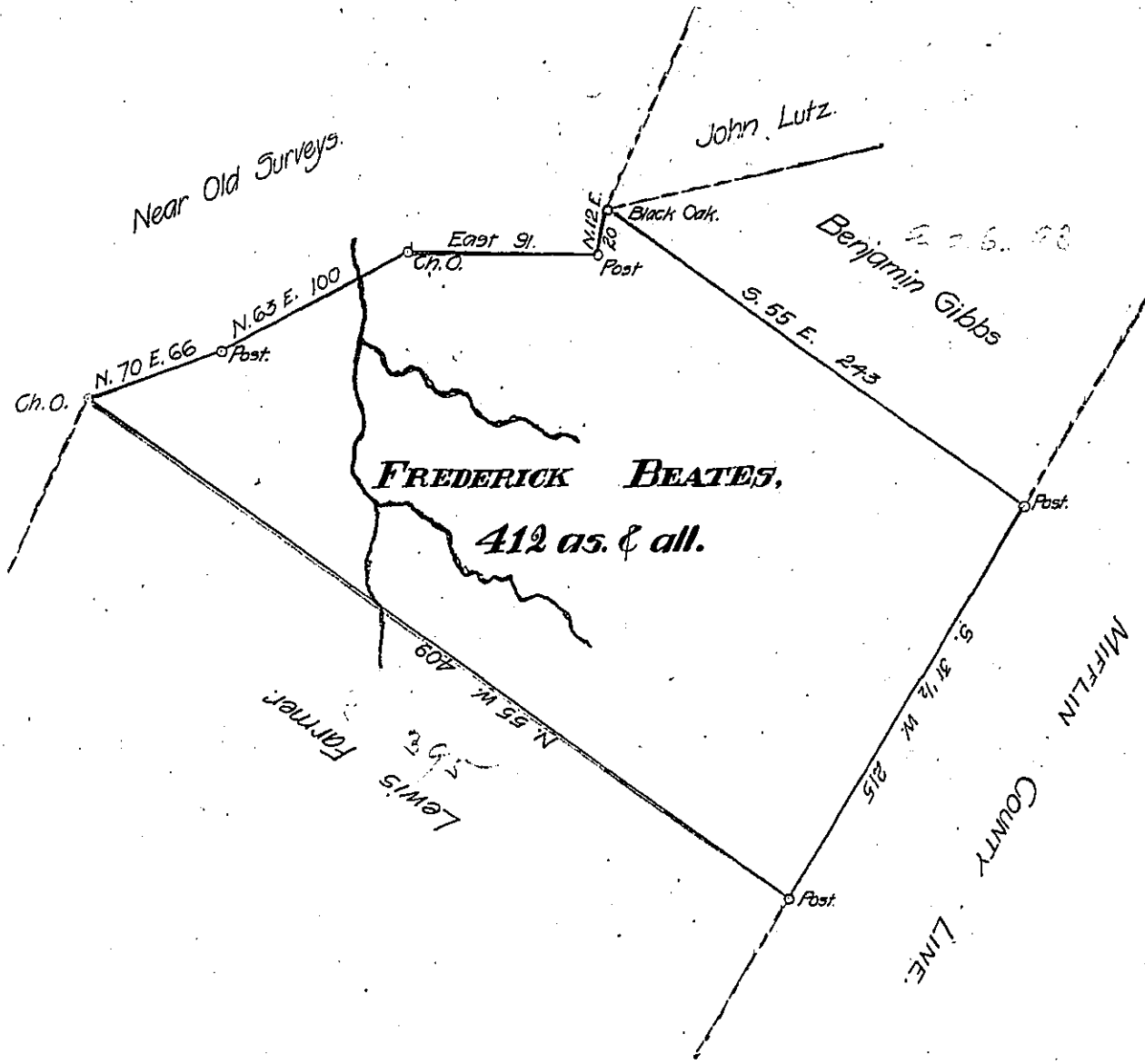


FORM NO. 1.

Surveyed the 9th day of November, 1795, in pursuance of a warrant granted to Frederick Beates, dated the 31st day March, 1794.
