



In pursuance of two Warrants, there was laid out and surveyed in Allemengel, on Stoney Run, now in Albany township, Berks County the above described tract of land, containing One hundred, eighty three acres ninety five perches, and allowance 8¹/₂. One of which said Warrants dated the 17th day of March A.D. 1749. was granted to Daniel Young the other of them dated the 13th day of June 1750. granted to George Lambert. and the said Daniel Young having assigned the right and title to his warrant unto George Lambert, a survey was thereupon made as above described.
