



The draft of a tract of land Situate in Catwissa Township in the County of Columbia and on the top of what is called the big Mountain Surveyed unto George A. Frick on the 18th February 1830 by Virtue of his Warrant dated 14 January 1830 Containing two hundred and thirty seven acres & twenty three perches and the Usual Allowance To Jacob Spangler Esq^r Tho^s Woodside D.S. Surveyor General.

This Survey may possibly interfere on its Southern boundary with surveys made for the Assylim Company but of this I am not certain not having found any lines on the ground
