Branch of the Susquehanna about two miles below the Town of Catewissa immediately below and near Clarks Island, opposite to Land formerly of Uriah Hughes about forty perches from the Southern Shore of Said River and about twenty perches from the Northern Shore of the Same in Catewissa Township in the County of Columbia Containing thirteen acres and thirty eight perches strict measure — Surveyed unto Ben<sup>d</sup> Vastine on the 20<sup>th</sup> June 1815 by Virtue of his Warrant dated 26<sup>th</sup> April 1815.
