



The above is a draft of a part of a tract of land situated in Brady township, Huntingdon (formerly Bedford) County, first surveyed in pursuance of a warrant granted to William Young dated 1st July, 1784 and said to contain This part re-surveyed and divided from said tract the 4th day of August, 1845; re-examined, found correct, and approved by me, the 11th day of January, A. D. 1853. Containing 363 acres and 62 perches & allowance.
