Acres & 150 perches (obl.) the allowance of six $\frac{1}{2}$ Cent for Roads & $\frac{1}{2}$ (Surveyed May 22^d 1766 by Robert McKensie under Richard Tea D.S. being one of the Tracts within the Boundaries of a large Survey made for George Croghan) Resurveyed - August 18th 1797 on warrant granted to John Shee dated June 3^d 1763

N.B. a Survey made for Francis Lyttle on George Woods D.S. Order dated Oct. 21st 1767 No 4514 Interferes with the above Survey.
