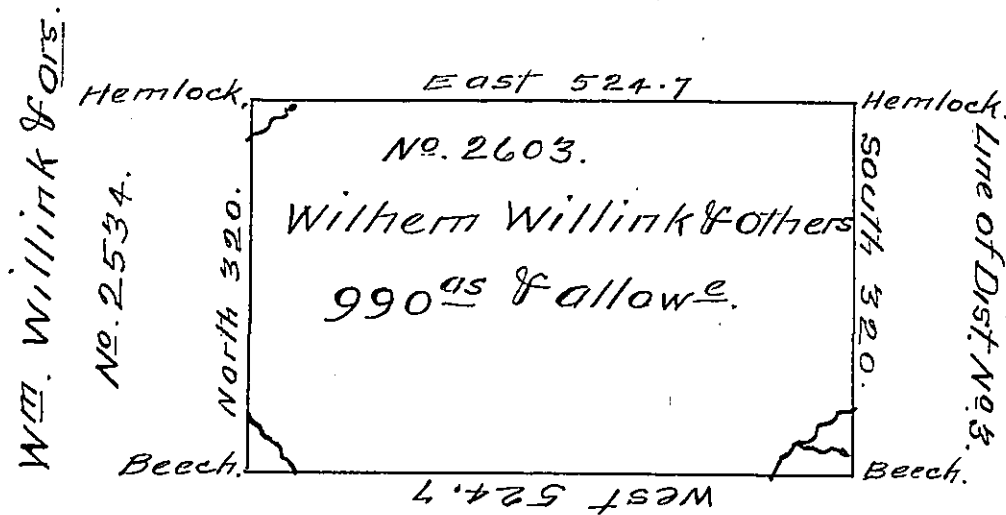

A Draught of a Tract of land situate in District No. 4 in the last purchase joining the the line of Dist. No. 3 from the Twenty three to the twenty four Mile Trees Surveyed the Eighth day of July 1793 in pursuance of a warrant No. 2603. to Wilhem Willink Nicholas Van Staphorst Christian Van Eggen Hendrick Vollenhoven and Rutger Jan Schimmelpinninck of Amsterdam for 900 <sup>as</sup>. Dated the twelfth day of December 1792 — Containing Nine Hundred & Ninety <sup>as</sup> & the usual allowance of six pt. Ct. for Roads &c.
