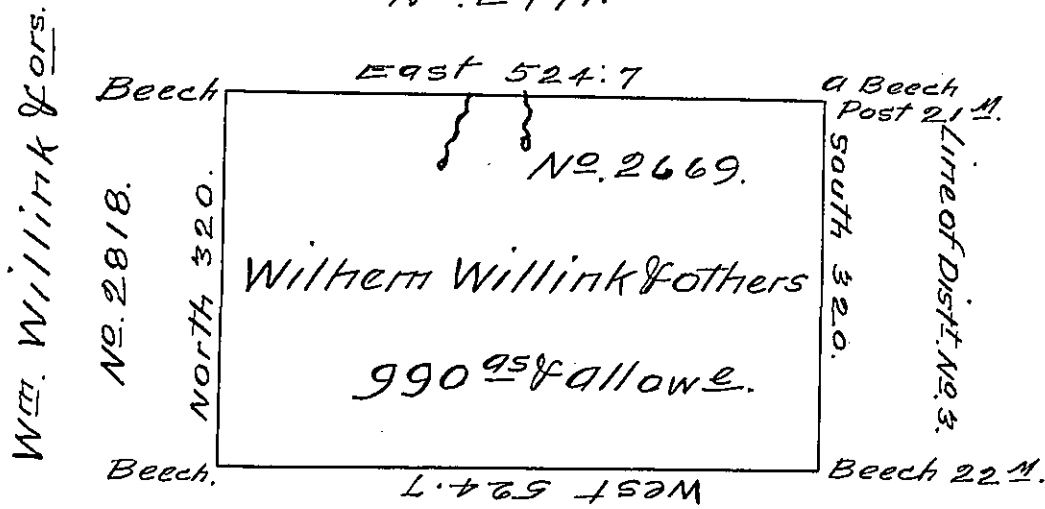

Containing Nine Hundred & Ninety 95 & the usuall allowe of six p^r ct. for Roads &c.
