



The above is a Draught of a survey made March 27th 1838 in pursuace of a Warrant granted to Abraham Williams for two Acres, dated March 17th 1838. Containing one hundred and fifteen perches and Allowance of six pr. Cent. situate in St. Clair Township Allegheny County being unimproved at the time of survey.

Note. Williams has signed over his right on the back of the Warrant to John Johnson for whom this survey was made & Returned.
