



The above described pieces of land containing together Fifty nine acres sixty six perches and allowance of Six per Cent for roads &c are parts of a larger Tract of 40 5/2 acres. Situate in Southampton Township Franklin County. Resurveyed 19<sup>th</sup> August 1812 in pursuance of an Order of the Board of Property dated 4<sup>th</sup> August 1812 & on a Warrant granted to Benjamin Blythe Junr bearing date 2<sup>nd</sup> of December 1785. The part marked A being also covered by a prior Warrant to Daniel Sley dated 29<sup>th</sup> of March 1773 & executed thereon 30<sup>th</sup> Dec<sup>r</sup> 1829 under contract with the Board of Property for returning unpatented lands under proprietary rights &c. Agreeable to which surveys 13 Acres 137 perches is appropriated to the Warrant of 1785 and 45 acres 98 perches to the prior Warrant of 1773.
