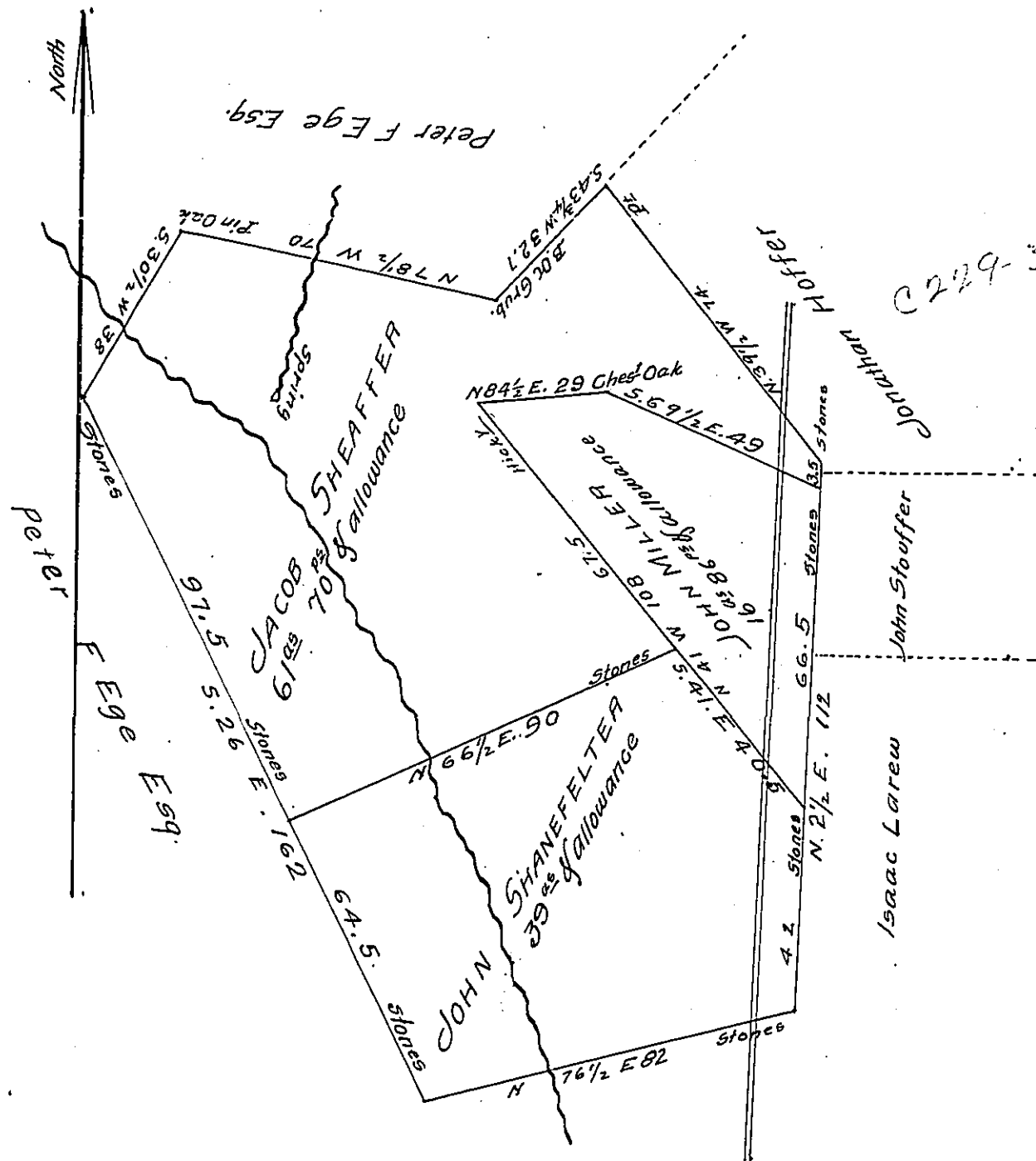

Jacob Sheaffer having part thereof 61^{as} 70^{ps} & allowance. John Shanefelter 39^{as} & allowance and John Miller 16^{as} 86^{ps} & allowance. containing in the whole 116^{as} 156^{ps} & allowance.

Jacob Sheaffers tract having a quantity of land cleared and a dwelling house & Stable thereon and John Shanefelter having a quantity of land cleared and also a dwelling house & stable thereon.
