



A Draught of a Tract of land called Frankstown Sleeping Place situate on the N.W. side of the Frankstown Branch of Juniatta — opposite to Franks old Town including the Old Sleeping place & big Spring adjoining of James Lowrey in Frankstown Township in the County of Bedford containing One hundred and <sup>four</sup> ~~three~~ acres and the usual allowance of Six p Cent for roads &c.

Surveyed the 31<sup>st</sup> day of May 1777 for Edward Johnson in pursuance of a Warrant dated the 3<sup>d</sup> day of February 1755

The above Survey was made by Thomas Smith Esquire when he had the District whose Field works I have examined and find to be accurate
