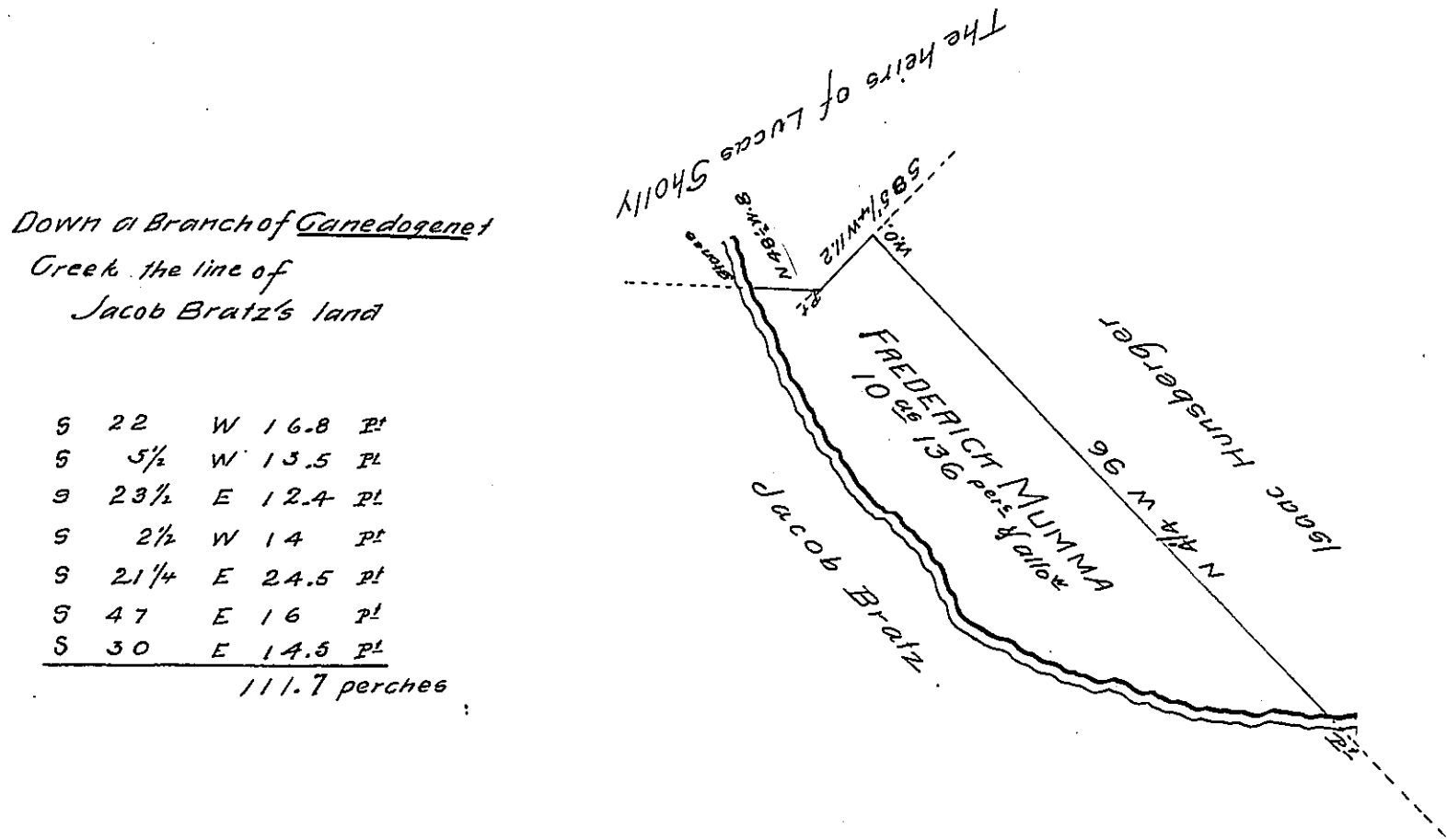

Domini 1814 - There was a family actually residing on said land at the time of making survey
