



A Draft of a Tract of land situate on Tusseys Run in Snake Spring Valley Providence Township Bedford County containing Two hundred and twenty acres and allowance of six per cent for roads &c. Surveyed for Charles More the 4<sup>th</sup> day of Nov<sup>r</sup> 1767 on Warrant dated the 7<sup>th</sup> day of July 1762

N. B. The dotted lines partly represent the draft of a tract of land surveyed for Henry Donnelly on Warrant dated the 17<sup>th</sup> day of May 1763. This tract interferes One hundred and eight acres and ninety six perches with the Charles More tract. Henry Donnelly devised the same to his widow & heirs who conveyed to Samuel Ewalt who conveyed to John Bennett who conveyed to Jacob Studabaker who conveyed to John Hersberger who devised the same to his widow the present owner
