



Situate on the west side of the Raystown branch of the Juniata river in Hope-  
 well township Bedford County, Containing 39 acres 50 perches & allowance of 6  
 per cent for roads &c. Surveyed the 24<sup>th</sup> & 25<sup>th</sup> of May 1852 in pursuance of a  
 warrant granted in the name of John Warsing Jun<sup>r</sup> for 39 acres & 64 perches  
 dated the 1<sup>st</sup> of October 1851, courses according to the true bearings.
