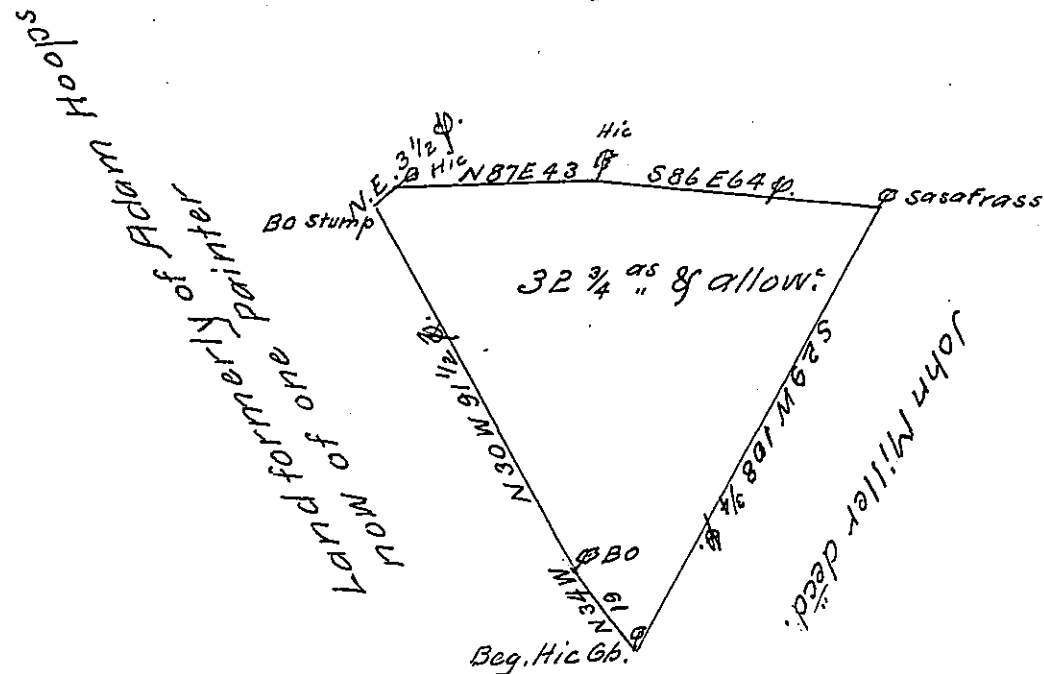


Land formerly of John Zack

A Draft of a Tract or Piece of Land situate in Guilford Township  
in the County of Franklin Containing thirtytwo Acres and three  
quarters and an Allowance proportional to Six & Cent for  
Roads &c. Survey'd September 24<sup>th</sup> 1793 in pursuance of  
a Warrant granted to Samuel Barr bearing Date the 24<sup>th</sup>  
Day of June 1793, Which Piece of Land is claimed by  
William Brotherton under his Warrant dated the 20<sup>th</sup> Day  
of April 1763 produced to me since the above Survey was made —
