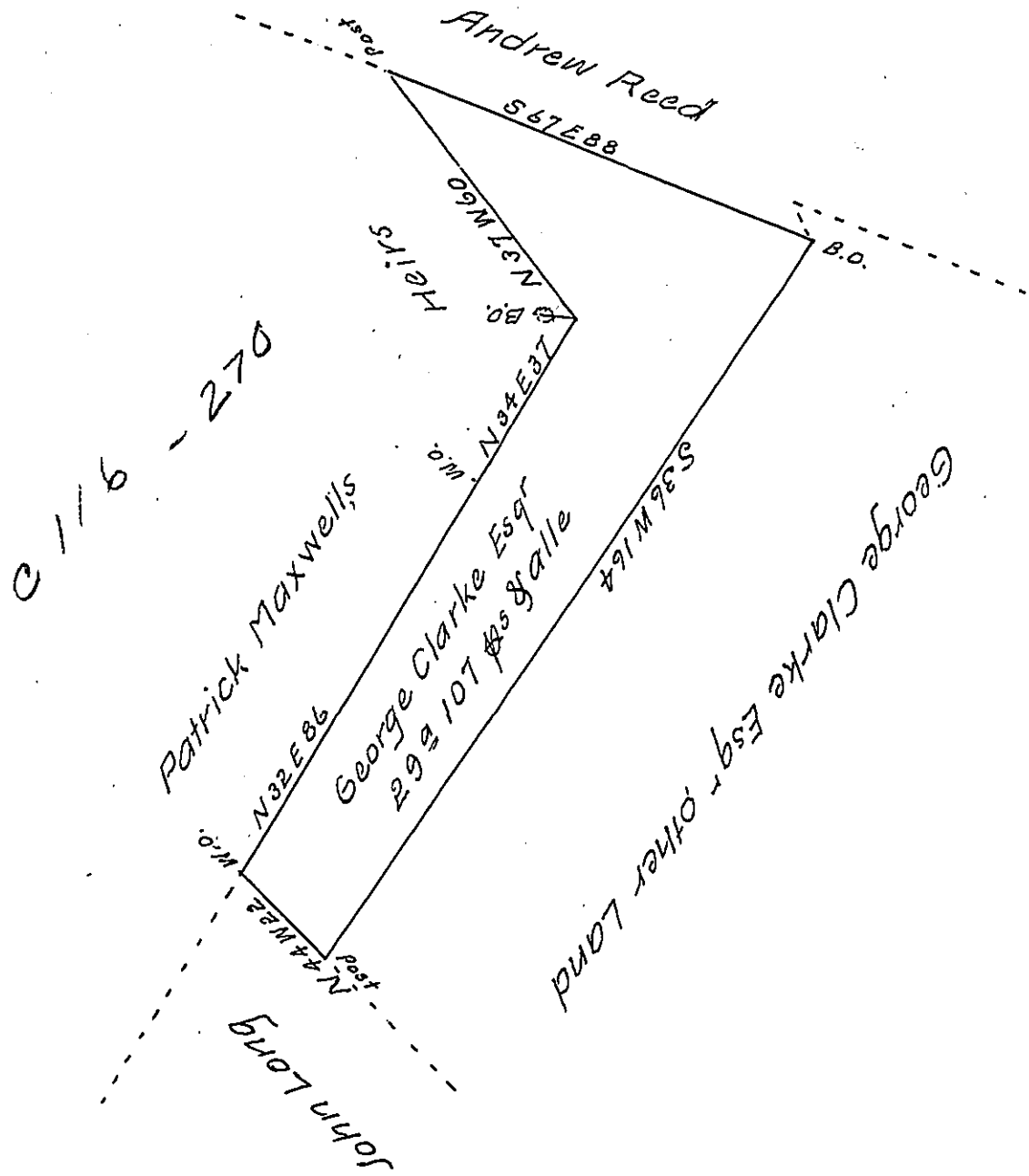

N.B. The above is Claimed by Miss Jane Burnside's on an Improve-  
 ment Consisting of an Small Cabbin and about three fourths of an  
 Acre cleared Prior to the 28<sup>th</sup> of March 1814 there is no Family  
 residing on the above. about One half of the above land is  
 cleared and been in the Occupancy of Mr Clarke previous to  
 Miss Burnside's Improvement A.F.
