



Draught of part of a tract of Land Situate in Montgomery Township Franklin County Containing Sixteen Acres and one hundred and thirty five perches & allowance of Six 1/2 Cent for Roads - Being part of a Tract of Ninety three Acres and three fourths & allowance - which was Surveyed in pursuance of a Warrant Granted William Duffield Senr for 100<sup>as</sup> Dated the 23<sup>rd</sup> day of May 1788. The remainder of said tract was claimed at the time of making the Original Survey by the Heirs of Doctor Robert Johnston on a Warrant granted Henry Cow Dated the 31<sup>st</sup> day of January 1794. Since which time there has been a tryal at Law and Decided in favour of the Heirs of Doctor Robert Johnston Resurveyed and laid off agreeable to said Decision for the Heirs of William Duffield Senr. the 4<sup>th</sup> day of October 1816.
