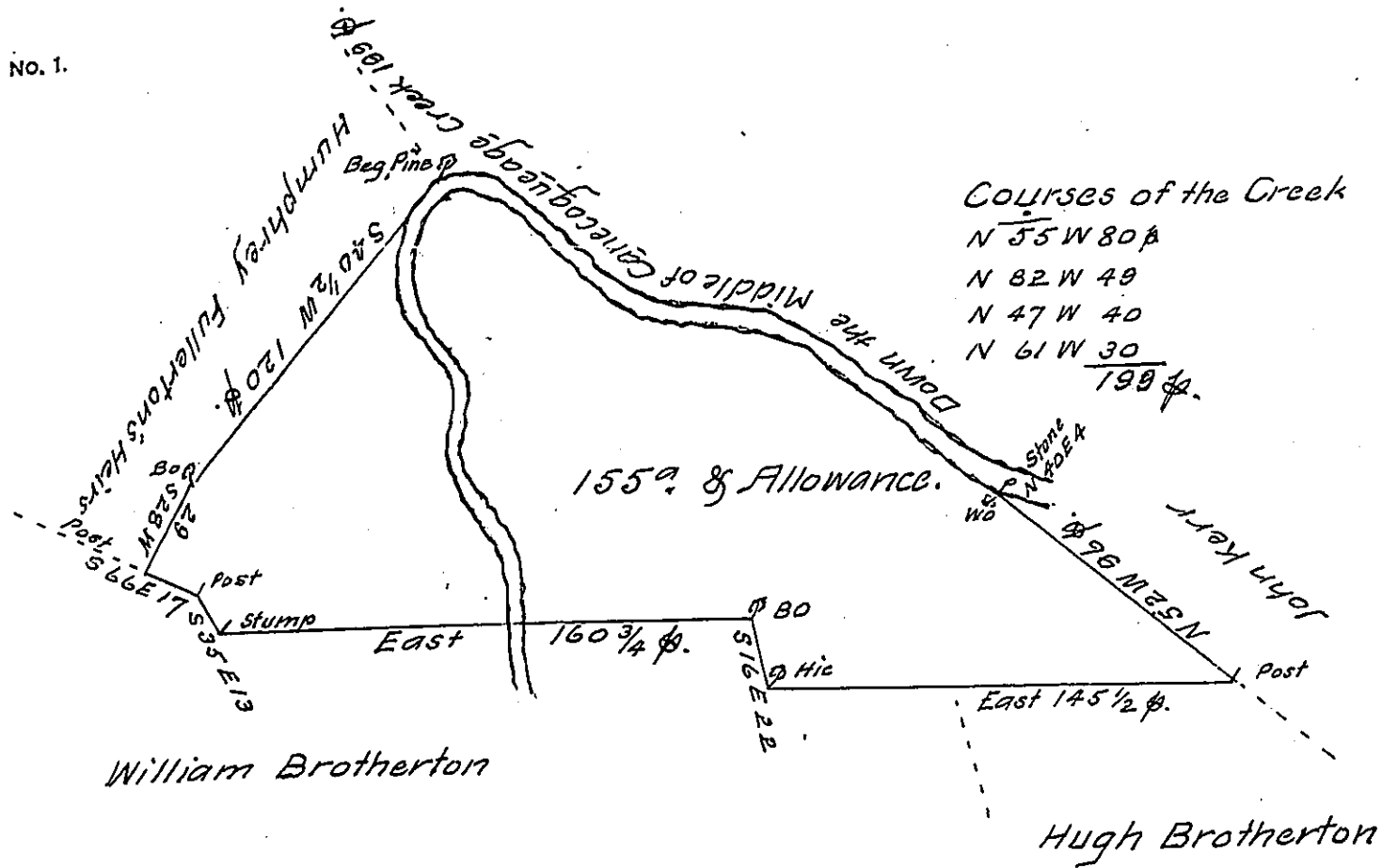


FORM No. 1.



A Draft of a Tract of Land situate in Guilford and Hamilton Townships in the County of Franklin Containing one hundred and fifty five Acres and the Allowance of Six p. Cent. for Roads &c. for which Andrew Dunlop and Edward Crawford have obtained a Warrant bearing Date the fifth Day of March 1793, in pursuance where of the above Tract was surveyed the 23<sup>d</sup> Day of April 1793, since which Patrick Jack hath made known his claim to the same by virtue of a Warrant by him alleged to have been granted to John M<sup>e</sup> Kenny and dated on or about the first Day of July 1762, and by said M<sup>e</sup> Kenny transferred to him. —

The Survey includes an old Improvement said to have been made or begun, by a certain William M<sup>e</sup> Kenny, Father of the said John M<sup>e</sup> Kenny, about forty Years ago. —
