That part of the Tract marked A Containing ninety three acres Forty nine perches & all is covered by a Warrant Granted to Samuel Dryden dated the 27th of Feb^y 1786 The part marked B Containing Twenty five acres Twenty Eight perches & all is part of 111^{acs} 85 per & all Which is covered by a Warrant to Samuel Dryden & Owen Aston dated the 2nd of November 1792 Resurveyed the 26th of May 1829 In pursuance of an Order of the Board of Property dated the 11th of May 1829 To Gab^l. Hiester Esq^t Sur^t. Gen^l.
