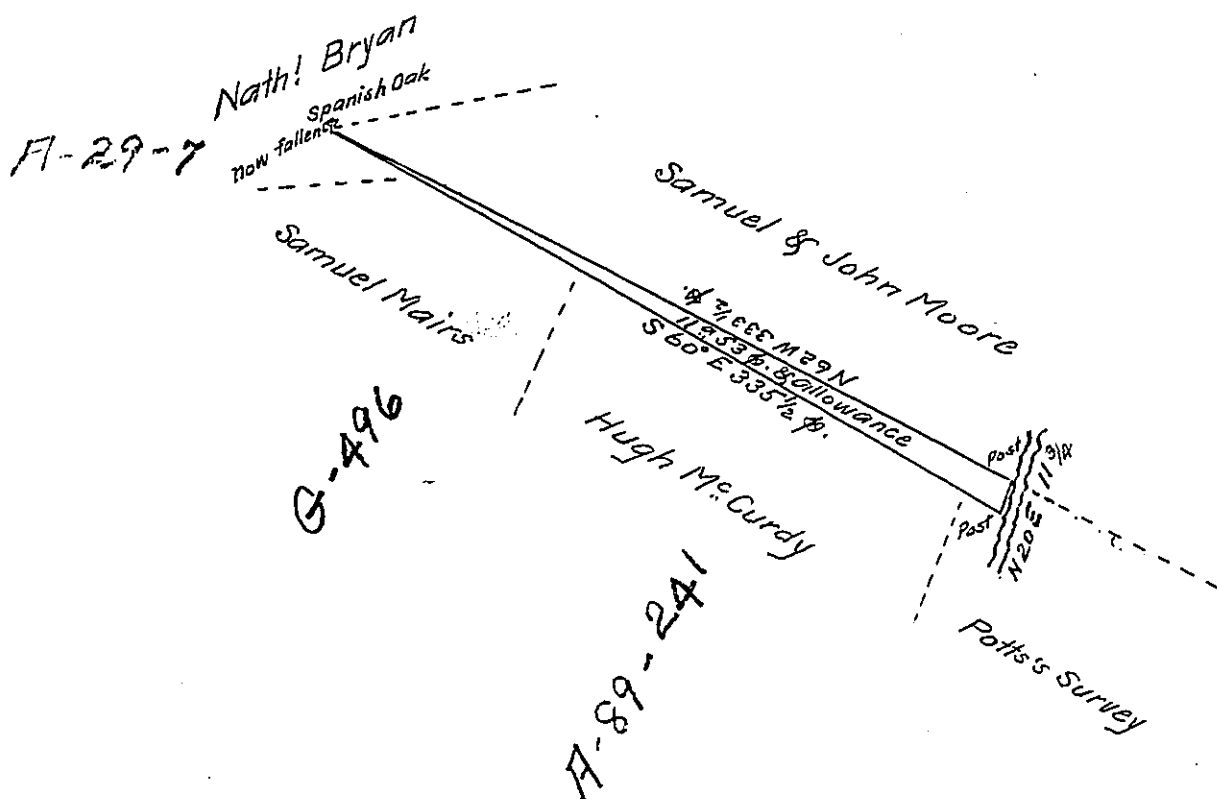


FORM NO. 1.



The above Draft describes a Piece of Land situate in Fannet Township in the County of Franklin, Containing eleven Acres and fifty three Perches and usual Allowance, for which a Warrant hath been granted to James McCurdy bearing Date the first Day of October 1792, disputed by Samuel & John Moore, alledging the same to be included in their old Survey. A Letter addressed to the Surveyor General, containing a statement of the Case, accompanies this. Math^w Henderson D.S.

N.B. A Survey was made & returned on a Warrant to Alexander Potts & Others, adjoining the above Piece before the Right to the same came in question, which Survey fell short of the quantity of their Warrant, Dated 17th Sept. 1784. M. H.
