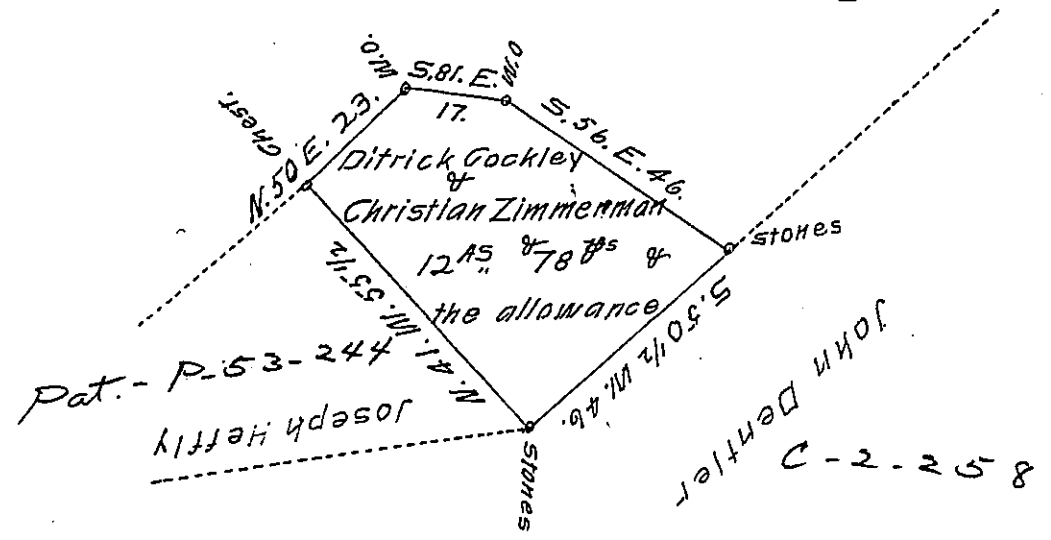

Surveyed the above described tract the 26th of August 1811 for John Martin.
