 in abediance to an order of apraisment granted to Frederick Hyneman
 Containing five acres and one hundred and four pe_ches strict meas-
 ure; Situate in the West Branch of Susquehanna in Lycoming County
 opposite Judge Hepburn's form on the North & Lands of Michael
 Ross on the South and about about fifteen perches from the North
 side of said river (know by the name of Hepburn's Island) - - - -
 And by virtue of a Warrant grated to Frederick Hyneman on
 the 17th day of April 1817, return the same on the eight day of
 May 1817 (on the former survey) - - - -
