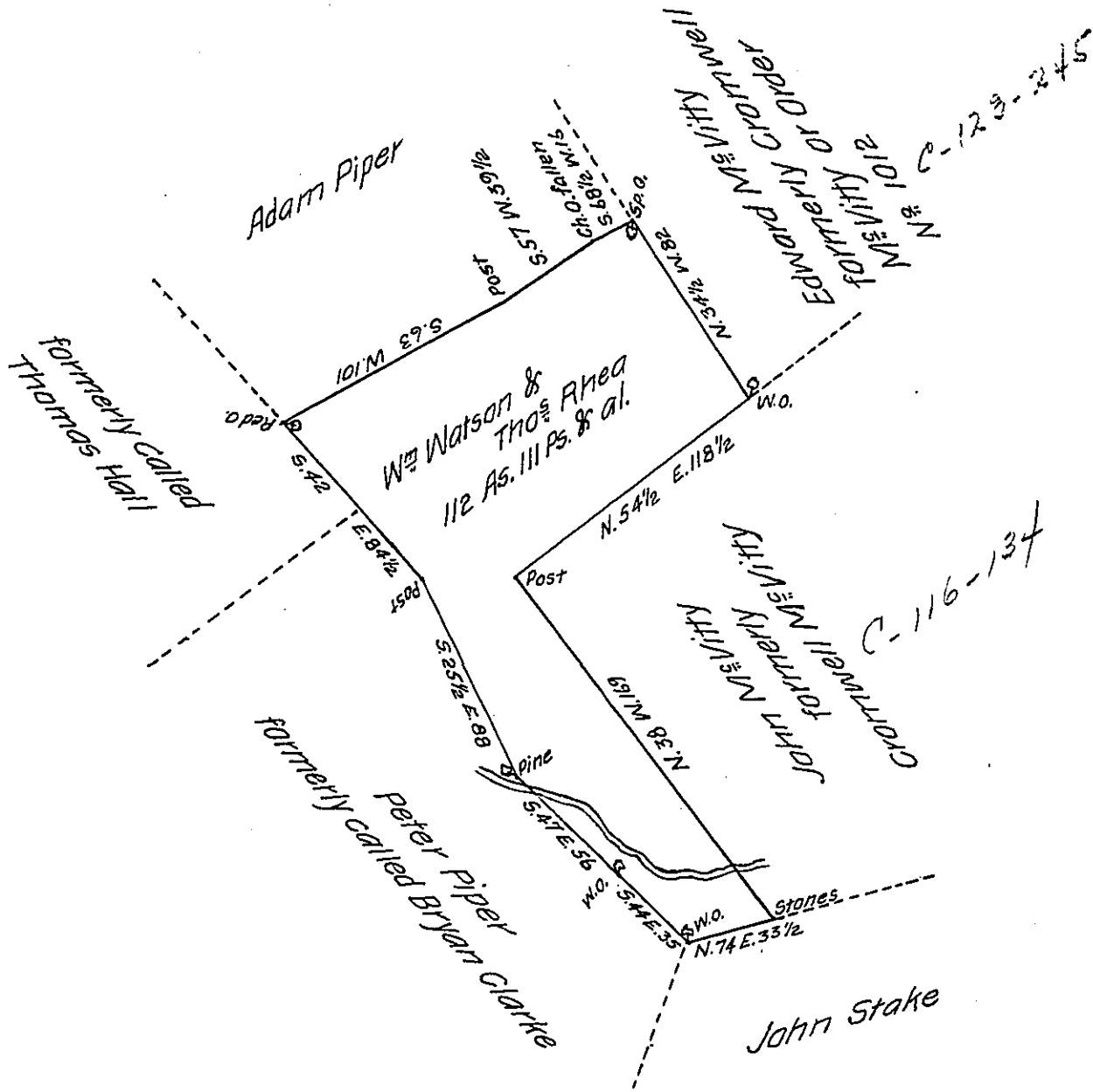


FORM NO 1.



Draught of a Tract of Land situate in Ambersons Valley Fannet Township Franklin Courty, containing one hundred and twelve Acres one hundred and eleven perches and allowance of six per cent for Roads, &c. Surveyed 22nd October 1829. In pursuance of a contract with the Board of Property for ascertaining, surveying and returning unpatented Lands under Proprietary rights, &c. And by virtue of an Order of Survey dated 25th June 1767 N^o 4043, Granted to William Watson & Thomas Ahea for 100 Acres "joining Bryan Clarke, Thomas Hall and Cromwell McVitty."
