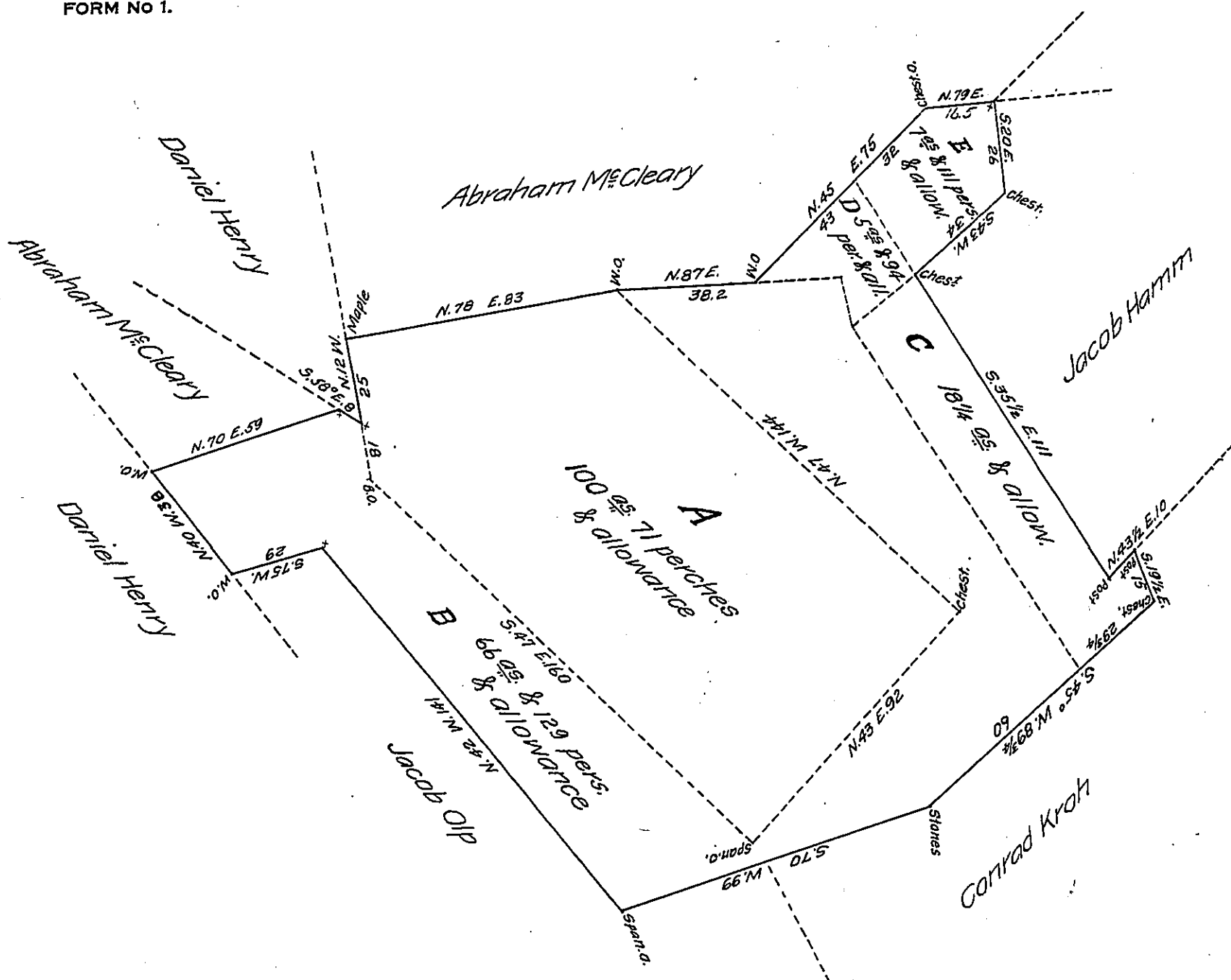


FORM NO 1.



*A Draught of a Tract of Land, Situate in Springfield Township, York  
York, Containing 208<sup>ac</sup> & 129 perches and allowance, part A containing 177<sup>1/4</sup> <sup>ac</sup>  
Originally surveyed in pursuance of a Warrant dated the 6<sup>th</sup> day of October 1785,  
& 71 perches & allow.  
Granted to Adam Rose, including a survey of 100<sup>ac</sup> made and Returned by virtue  
of his Application N<sup>o</sup> 2760, part B containing 18<sup>1/4</sup> <sup>ac</sup> originally surveyed in pursu-  
ance of a Warrant dated the 18<sup>th</sup> day of April 1774, Granted to William Spittler, and the  
part C, containing 13<sup>ac</sup> & 46 perches and allowance. Originally surveyed in pursu-  
ance of two Warrants, dated the 18<sup>th</sup> day of August 1803. Granted to James Allison.*

*And now at the request of the owner Conrad Rorer, the same has  
been calculated, examined, &c. and at his request returned for Confirmation the  
25<sup>th</sup> day of October A. D. 1864. Per. Benj<sup>t</sup> Leese, D. S.*
